How to use this Prayer Guide

As creatures that exist in relationship with God, we depend upon communication. God communicates with us primarily through His Word, but also by the working of the Holy Spirit within our lives. We communicate with Him primarily through prayer and worship.

When we speak with God, almost every expression can fit into one or more of four categories: adoration, confession, thanksgiving, or supplication. Adoration is praising God for who He is and what He has done. Confession is agreeing with God about the wrong He already knows we have done or the crying out to Him about that which tempts us. While there are corporate expressions of these first two, they are most often expressed personally, between self and God. The last two categories are often broader and more easily shared for corporate prayer.

This year, we have listed the major prayer points for each of our ministries in the last two of these groups — thanksgiving and supplication. These are, respectively, expressing gratitude for His blessing and requesting His provision.

It is our desire that you join with us as your church family in making these praises and requests a part of your regular time with God and prayer life. Thank you for making 2024 another year of Valley Baptist Church faithfully praying to our good and gracious Lord.

PRAYER TOOLS

A.C.T.S.

ADORATION

When we pray, our minds and hearts should be in the proper state as we approach the throne of our most holy and high King. Give Him the praise and honor He is worthy of receiving.

Psalm 145:1-7

I will extol You, my God, O King,

And I will bless Your name forever and ever.

Every day I will bless You,

And I will praise Your name forever and ever.

Great is the Lord, and highly to be praised,

And His greatness is unsearchable.

This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.

Hebrews 4:16

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin. Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

SPEAK FROM YOUR HEART

God is kind and gracious — He does not require some special combination of words or incantation. We can come before Him with boldness, sharing with Him whatever is on our minds and hearts. Some things to remember:

- BE REVERENT. God is holy and we are to approach Him as such. Speak to God with respect, honoring Him as Creator, Lord, and Savior.
- BE APPROPRIATE. We cannot ask God for anything sinful or opposed to His will and expect that He will grant our request. But we can pray according to His nature and character, and trust that He will always do what is best.
- **BE HUMBLE.** Do not come to God with a proud heart, demanding He submit to you and your will. Humble yourself like a subject kneeling before a king and magnify God.
- BE HONEST. God cannot be fooled by crafty speech or omission of fact.
- BE LIKE THE TAX COLLECTOR in Luke 18 who, "standing some distance away, was even unwilling to lift up his eyes to heaven, but was beating his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me, the sinner!'" This man approached God with a proper heart and attitude, and in complete dependence.

- Pray for the peace of Israel and Gaza, as well as the rest of the Middle East. Pray for the protection of the innocent. Pray that the wicked who have caused and perpetuated this conflict will surrender to the Lordship of Christ and turn from their wicked ways. Pray for God to use this awful conflict to draw those in Gaza, Israel, and the rest of the world to Himself. Pray for Arab and Israeli Christians in the region to be bold in their faith and grant them protection as they proclaim Christ.
