## **DESCRIPTION OF SPIRITUAL GIFTS**

**Leading** - Literally "to stand in front." The desire and ability to lead and direct others in the church to follow the Lord and do the work of ministry.

**Exhortation** - The desire and ability to motivate other Christians to trust and obey God.

**Serving** - The desire and ability to serve with joy in a way that benefits others. The process of serving is satisfying as well as the end result.

**Teaching** - The desire and ability to communicate the meaning and application of the Bible in a way people can understand.

**Giving** - The desire and ability to sacrificially and generously give to the Lord's work with joy. This gift may or may not at times include the ability to make money in order to give more.

**Mercy** - The desire and ability to have sympathy for and show mercy toward those who are in need or pain.

**Wisdom** - The desire to know and the ability to apply biblical knowledge to making godly choices in life.

**Knowledge** - The desire and ability to investigate and understand the Word of God and explain it to others.

**Faith** - The desire and ability to depend upon God's trustworthiness and act upon the truthfulness of Scripture.

**Celibacy** - The desire and ability to stay single in order to fully devote yourself to ministry. (Matthew 19:10-12; 1 Corinthians 7:7)

**Discernment** - The desire and ability to distinguish between that which is of God and that which is ultimately from an evil source (1 John 4:1-6).

**Administration** - The desire and ability to steer and guide others in the work of ministry and to manage ministry affairs in the church.

**Helping** - The desire and ability to support, assist, and work in a ministry without necessarily being in charge of it. The desire to bless others in the church by helping those who need support or assistance.

**Hospitality** - The desire and ability to make people feel welcome, especially by using your home or food to minister to people.
